

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KRASIS

Beyond the surface of our reality, blurry and fractured, there is a background of co-existence, a woven fabric of connexions, a movement like a helix of multiple strands with modes of communication that are implicit and intelligible to all the living bodies of the world.

The term *KRASIS* originates from ancient Greek: the action of mixing or blending two or more things. For this performance, we were inspired by the writings of the philosopher E. Coccia. He used this term to describe an essential feature of the inner workings of the world: "A total mixture in which all bodies occupy the same space, while still preserving their qualities and individuality." For us, this image entails a vision for the contemporary world that seems attentive to its nature and to its complex movements, as well as a potential for an acceptable, or, even more, a desirable future.

The world as a mixture of organic and mineral matter, consciousnesses, machines and rubble.

KRASIS aims to point to the existence of a common ground for conversation - a contemporary state of mind that intersects multiple points of view without erasing individualities.

On the contrary - in doing so, it is revealing them.

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A moment suspended between the rational and the irrational, nature and technology, reality and fantasy. These notions are not in dichotomy; they intertwine and live together, hybridize and eliminate any possibility of our bodies isolating from each other.

New spaces emerge; protruding thoughts, perceptions unheard of before. Different natures mixing, implicit modes of communication, revealing what we could not have foreseen, creating infinite, unpredictable, dizzying, accidental, sudden, paradoxical, magnificent, striking connections. Simultaneously, here and on the other side, a clamour for being in a sensational or in a sensitive voice.

Everything is connected. A common living background is woven out of multiple points of view.

INTERACTIVITY

KRASIS is an interactive performance. The two artists are present on stage.

Each artist is working in a different media, but playing is interactive, with interconnected controllers for their respective devices. Their actions control variations in both medias. This allows for a dialogue between image and sound. The result is a sandbox, allowing them to create, explore and play with materials in real time, in front of the audience.







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LIVE VISUALS - CREATIVE PROCESS

I composed the visuals for **KRASIS** in several stages. The first one is drawing. I used hand drawing on an iPad to create textures and contours for visual materials. I also did several photography sessions with compositions of objects or portraits in order to obtain more raw visual material. The next stage is the development of more complex scenes, by combining and shaping these materials, mixing, moving and deforming, resulting in a series of still images. Each of these describes a dynamic, reflecting the gestures that shaped it. With each of these images I try to capture a precise sensation in a single take: suspension, collapse, surprise, astonishment. This becomes the story board for the performance.

The third stage is recreating these scenes in 3D. Sometimes abstract, sometimes figurative, it consists of building a visual cartography for the performance with several precise narrative markers and space for play and improvisation.

The last step is the programming of a gestural control system for this 3D world, like a control / play system. I use different controllers to manipulate the 3D objects in real time, with play gestures, during the performance.

A second influence is exerted by the data coming from the sound.





LIVE MUSIC - CREATIVE PROCESS

The live performance becomes a mix between 3 types of animation:

- baseline animation for each material or object
- added animation reactive to the sound parameters
- live playing on the controllers some parts are written and some are improvised

The latter type gives the main dynamics of the visuals.

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LIVE MUSIC - CREATIVE PROCESS

I compose and play live with a setup of electronic instruments (synthesizers, modulars, effects).

For **KRASIS**, which brings into play different ways of perceiving time and space, I am trying to express things like depth, closeness and distance, through filters, strong contrasts, dynamic nuances and sudden fractures in the sound mass that can give way to tenuous filaments.

The orchestral dimension has an important place in **KRASIS**, with timbres close to the sound of a symphonic orchestra, such as strings, timbales and brass. This reinforces the notion of sidereal space and its possible temporalities.

These timbres engage in a dialogue or appear in opposition to more electronic colors: saturated, distorted, or cold and synthetic sounds.





From the beginning of the piece, we cross a wall of extremely powerful sound followed by a time of suspension: a vertigo and a tipover. Artists and public share this experience of passage. Wandering, floating and suspension are developed from soft tones, impacts or surprises that tend to destabilize comfort.

Finally, I try to express the feeling of astonishment in front of the power of that which exceeds us: an incredible beauty and, at the same time, fear, in front of this absolute.

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ANNABELLE PLAYE



Annabelle Playe is a multidisciplinary artist. She enjoys exploring voice, sound, video and writing. She studied classical singing and composition with Sergio Ortega in Paris. She is a soprano and she interprets contemporary music.

Today her music is oscillating between electroacoustic, drone, and noise. She focuses on the physicality of sound and on timbre, with an emphasis on musical structure. Her live setup is made of electronic instruments. She performs in France and abroad.

She plays alongside Marc Siffert, Alexis Forestier, Hugo Arcier, Alexandra Radulescu, and the choreographers Mylène Benoît and Marcela S. Corvalan.

In 2010, she founded "AnA compagnie", a production compagny dedicated to cross-disciplinary projects.

Her first albums "Matrice" (2012), "Vaisseaux" (2014) and "Geyser" (2019) were published under the label DAC Records.

She wrote two theatre monologues, "Ligne" and "Mater", published in French by Alna Editions.

From 2018 to 2020 she was an associated composer with "Scènes Croisées de Lozère" through the DGCA-SACEM Platform. She was awarded the SACD prize "Musique de Scène" with her music for the play "Delta Charlie Delta" by M. Simonot. She received the SACD New Talent Music Award 2019. She performed at "Vive le Sujet!" for the 73rd Avignon Festival and she was selected by the Face Foundation for a tour in the U.S. with her piece "Geyser". She created "InLAND" at the 104 Centre in Paris for Biennale Némo.

ALEXANDRA RĂDULESCU

Alexandra Rădulescu is a media artist and designer with a focus on interactive and immersive experiences.

Working at the intersection between media art, technology and design, she is driven by a desire to consolidate and extend our relationship to technology through tangible and gesture based interfaces. She strives to create experiences that are focused, clear and uncluttered, but also playful, evocative and expressing identity. She appeals to the imagination of her audience, to their emotions and their creativity, addressing their attention but also the pleasure of moving their bodies.

She has a Master's degree in industrial design from ENSCI - Les Ateliers, Paris (2016). Her graduation project, *FLUX* - an electronic musical instrument with expressive gestural control - was rewarded with a Red Dot Award 2017.

Guest lecturer at ENSCI - Les Ateliers in 2019, teaching a virtual reality studio. Independent VR experience designer for companies, design studios and artist studios.

As a visual artist, she creates real time 3D works and is part of several duos for live audiovisual shows: with Roland Cahen for his pieces "Nanoballad" and "Kinetic Design", with Peine Rose for his live set "Alterity" and with Annabelle Playe for their joint project, "KRASIS". She also created live visuals sets for two theatre pieces: "Naïves hirondelles" (Compagnie Tangente) and "Nuage et pantalon" (Gare au Théâtre).

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HUGO ARCIER

Hugo Arcier is a French digital artist (actually, an artist in the digital world) who uses 3D computer graphics in various ways: videos, prints and sculptures. Devoted first to special effects for feature films, he has worked on numerous projects with prestigious directors such as Roman Polanski, Alain Resnais or Jean-Pierre Jeunet.

This profession has allowed him to gain a deep understanding of digital tools – in particular 3D graphic images – which is essential for the birth of his projects. He regularly works on commissioned artworks using computer graphics, like for the album cover "Cruel Summer" for Kanye West (2012).

Since 2004 he has been focusing on artworks that meticulously dissect the specificities of 3D computer graphics and virtual worlds, being part of a new form of art. His artistic works have been featured in numerous festivals (Elektra, Videoformes, Némo, etc.), in collective exhibitions in galeries and various art venues (New Museum, Palais de Tokyo, New Media Art Center of Sichuan Fine Arts Institute, galerie Magda Danysz, galerie Plateforme, etc.) and contemporary art fairs (Variation, Slick).

His works has been shown in two monographic exhibitions in France: "Nostalgie du réel" in 2013 at Le Cube and "Fantômes numériques" in 2016 at Lux Valence. He was named "Chevalier de l'ordre des Arts et des Lettres" in 2016 by the French Minister of Culture Audrey Azoulay.

He is the founder and creative director of N° 130 Creative Studio. He is an active member of the artist-run space Plateforme Paris.

He is represented as an art director by Bent Design Lab (US, Canada, China).

AnA* COMPAGNIE

AnA Compagnie is conducting a global project around **contemporary creative processes** focusing on **musical composition** in connection with **electronic instruments** and **new technologies.** Several different media, like the digital arts, poetry, theatre and dance are all drawing the contours of our artworks. We aim to bring a shift in the way we listen and in the way we look at the world. Each piece and the way we anticipate its reception, both direct its format towards either a concert, a live audiovisual performance / show, or an installation.

By providing this multidisciplinary space of expression, the company is committed to **support artists with singular or hybrid universes**, offering the audience unique experiences of each of the themes convered.

The artistic connections within AnA Compagnie involve complex thought processes and a strong commitment to our aesthetic choices, in order to bring about a plurality of formats and fertile crossovers between artworks. In order for our audiences to absorb these processes and use them to develop their own creativity, it is important for us to take some time for sharing. We organize workshops for teaching artistic practices, conferences and meet ups.

Since 2010, AnA Compagnie has created **6 audiovisual performances** ("ANA", "Matrice", "Vaisseaux", "Overview", "InLAND | come back in broad day", "Krasis"), **2 shows for young audiences** centered around contemporary vocal music ("Couak!" and "Leçons de choses"), **a song concert** ("Songs"), **several vocal performances, an installation** ("Vaisseaux"), **two electronic solos** ("Gold" and "Geyser"), **gave readings and lectures** ("Vocal Music in the 20th and 21st Centuries", "Physicality of Sound", "Les Phonosphères ou les Gloses à Sons"), **a performance** - "Les corps citadelles", as well as "Pontonniers" at "Vive le Sujet!" for the **73rd Festival d'Avignon** (coproduction SACD - Festival d'Avignon). In 2019, AnA Compagnie took over the show "Delta Charlie Delta" initially produced by the Samovar Company.

The next creations focus on poetry on one hand, with "ICE DOMINO", and on dance, music and light on the other hand with "MAGNA".
